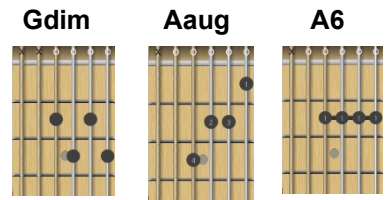


# Alone Again Naturally (Gilbert O'Sullivan)

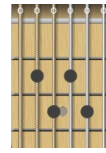


INTRO: A Amaj7 A Amaj7
