

# Early Morning Rain Chords by Ian & Sylvia

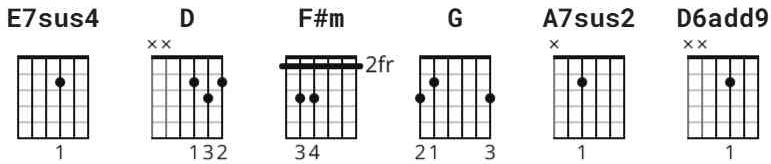


Difficulty: intermediate

Playing tip: in order to easily play the F#7sus4, I recommend playing the bass note on the 6th string (F#) with your thumb.
