

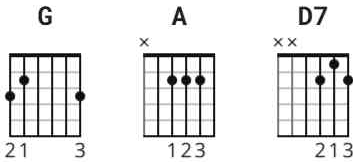
# Draft Dodger Rag Chords by Phil Ochs

## CHORDS



This is the way Phil played it at the Democratic Convention.....
