

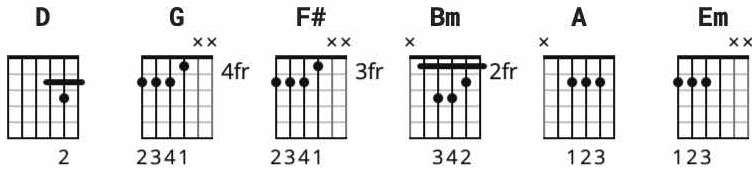
# One Headlight Official by The Wallflowers
